Project Overview



The European postal industry is a key contributor to the European economy with an increased importance during the COVID-19 pandemic. The once traditional sector is currently moving fast to a

new digital era while also undertaking concrete actions on environmental issues.

The DigiGreeNPost project intends to bring resilience to the postal industry through the provision of upskilling for postal employees in green and digital competence areas, acting as an enabler towards the implementation of digital and green policy agendas, building the understanding of the importance of digital and green-related jobs

throughout the sector.

The project will achieve this goal through the following activities: a Transnational Ecosystem for DigiGreen Skilled Postal Employees, Two New Skills Curricula, Pilot delivery of Trainings, a Dual Recognition Scheme in the Postal



Sector as well as Dissemination and Exploitation Activities.

Outputs that will be produced from the above-mentioned activities are:

- Upgrade of Sectoral Profiles with new skills,
- a Competence Framework,
- a DigiGreen Post Model,
- two Competence-based Curricula,
- a new Joint Training Scheme including Web Based Learning (WBL),
- an e-learning platform,
- Individual Learning Accounts (with Micro-credentials awarding)
- and a new "Cross-Border" Certification Scheme.








Consortium

The project consortium is led by the Greek partner AKMI S.A, which is an institution specialized in vocational education & training (VET) provider and it includes the following partners: PostEurop (Belgium), Instruction & Formation (Ireland), CPIP "Center for Promoting Lifelong Learning" (Romania), Hellenic Open University (Greece), Institute for Political Ecology (Croatia), EVBB (Germany), Hellenic Post – ELTA S.A. (Greece), Posta Romana (Romania), EUROCERT (Romania), BK-Con (Germany), and SLING (Belgium).



The DigiGreeNPost **Project** alliance will create а common learning and skills recognition framework, user friendly and accessible by all postal workers. who are seeking jobs in postal and delivery companies

in different countries across the EU. By influencing the current status of the qualification frameworks as well as affecting the Vocational Education and Training (VET) offered in each country, our project will enable mobility of postal workers and to unify therefore the postal sector in the EU.

PostEurop, as the umbrella organization for all postal representatives in Europe, is the main partner in charge of the project's dissemination



and communication activities, along with all project partners. PostEurop has made substantial progress in the first part of the project by achieving major accomplishments in terms of DigiGreeNPost Project dissemination and promotion, laying the groundwork for the project's continuance. More significantly, PostEurop is engaging target audiences and end users, which adds value to the desired impact.





The expected results of the DigiGreeNPost Project will be:

- the resilience and harmonization of the EU postal industry under common initiatives,
- the reinforcement of digitalization in the postal sector, the adaptation of green practices,
- the creation of "digigreen" skilled workforce and the enhancement of their employability,
- the creation of synergies between the Education Providers and the sector representatives.
