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Learning Objectives & Outcomes:

The online discussion was conducted by representatives of the CPIP team in collaboration with "Emanuil Ungureanu" Technical College Timisoara and Timis County Post Office. During the event (1h:30 min) the representative of the Technical College "Emanuil Ungureanu" Timișoara shared the experience of participating in the DigiGreen Post project activities organized in France and Germany. The topics discussed during the two training missions within the project were highlighted to inform the participants about the impact of the project so far.

Ms. Giuchici Minodora participated in the EuroSkills Gdansk 2023 competition (Olympiad), the largest event dedicated to vocational education and training and excellence in crafts in Europe, a 3-day competition in Poland. EuroSkills Gdansk 2023, comprised 43 different sessions (trades) in which more than 600 young professionals, pupils and students under the age of 25 from 32 countries competed. EuroSkills competitors are among the best young professionals in their countries in the fields in which they compete and are selected to compete in EuroSkills after having participated in national competitions held in WorldSkills Europe member countries. - *the structure and format of the WorldSkills and EuroSkills competitions;*

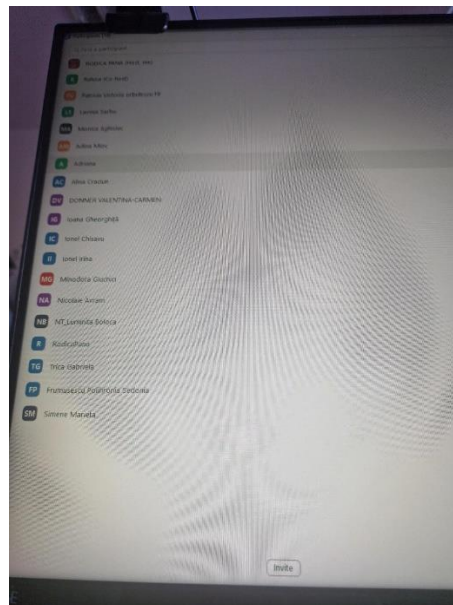
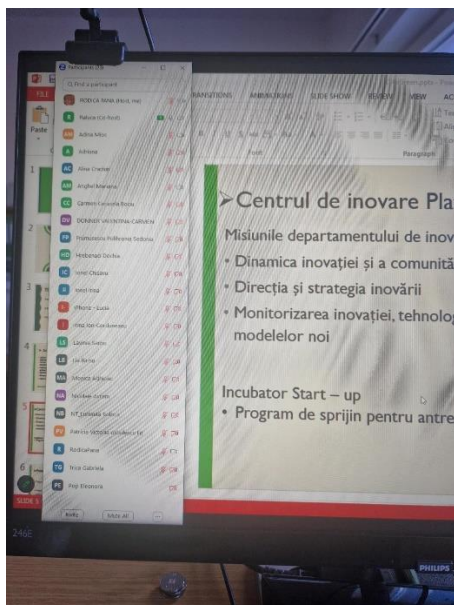
Another primary school teacher shared her classroom experience: unconsumed biscuits at school turned into anti-sniff balls. There were discussions about a future collaboration (partnership)

Outcomes: Participants gained insights into practical CSR initiatives and their potential impact on local communities, knowledge about the role of innovation departments in fostering community development and strategic innovation planning, understanding the process of nurturing and implementing entrepreneurial ideas within a start-up incubator setting, knowledge of nationally recognized training programs and the value of certifications in professional development, understanding the switch to green fuel, research trends, and sustainability practices in logistics, fostering awareness of environmentally friendly practices, understanding of vocational competitions and their role in showcasing excellence in crafts and skills development, exploring the potential for collaboration, educational projects and strategies for sustainable learning and project implementation.

By collectively addressing skill gaps and improving training offers, organizations can form collaborative networks, sharing resources and best practices for the mutual benefit of the entire postal sector.

The event was organised over 1h:30 and there was no specific agenda related to the event. The discussion was based on the following key points: overview of the DigiGreen Post project, its objectives and what has been achieved so far and how participants can benefit from them, discussion about the training missions organised within the project and the experiences gained, exchange of best practices in the field in order to initiate an open dialogue for improving the training offer.


