About the project

The DigiGreeN Post project addresses the critical need to enhance the digital and green skills of the postal workforce, fostering their adaptability and performance in response to the industry's transformation. By equipping employees with these essential competencies, the project supports the sector's transition to sustainability and digitalization, ensuring its competitiveness and resilience in the face of evolving socio-economic and environmental challenges.

DigiGreeN Post Project – Transnational Partners Meeting – Timisoara, Romania

The DigiGreeN Post Project's Transnational Partners Meeting took place in Timişoara, Romania, on June 20-21, 2024. Hosted by CPIP, the meeting gathered partners from across Europe to review the project's progress and strategically plan for its next steps.



Day 1 Highlights

The first day kicked off with registration and opening remarks, where CPIP welcomed participants and set a collaborative tone for the two-day event. A major focus of the





day was Work Package 4 (WP4), which involves the development of new skills curricula and joint training schemes. Led by Vangelis Makris from AKMI, discussions centred on the design of an e-learning platform, the integration of innovative learning activities, and the finalization of assessment methodologies. The team also explored work-based learning approaches and training guides, with valuable input from postal sector representatives.

Daniela Huber from CPIP led the discussions on Work Package 5 (WP5), which focuses on the pilot delivery of these training schemes. Topics included the recruitment of learners, the planning of training activities, and strategies for evaluating the effectiveness of the programs. Progress was also made on Work Package 6 (WP6), with Delia Stan from Eurocert presenting advancements on the development of a dual recognition scheme, which includes creating Individual Learning Accounts borders, ensuring consistency and quality.







Day 2 Highlights

The second day began with a deep dive into Work Package 1 (WP1), with AKMI focusing on project management and coordination. This session ensured that all partners were aligned on the administrative and strategic aspects of the project, with

an emphasis on streamlining efforts for maximum impact. Sadullah Altuntas from BK then led discussions on Work Package 2 (WP2), addressing quality assurance and evaluation processes. Ensuring the highest standards across all deliverables remains a priority for the project.



Dissemination and exploitation activities were a major theme of the final session, led by Mr. Angjelo Andoni and Mr. Waqas Ahsen from PostEurop under Work Package 7 (WP7). The group discussed strategies to increase the project's visibility, engage stakeholders, and



effectively share outcomes with a wider audience. The meeting concluded with a forward-looking reflection on the project's achievements to date and the path ahead.



DigiGreeN Post Project – Online Consultation Webinar: Creating a Work-Based Learning Scheme for DigiGreen Postal Employees

On July 18, 2024, in the framework of DigiGreeNPost Project, PostEurop together with

AKMI (Project Coordinator) hosted an online webinar titled "Creating a Work-Based Learning Scheme for DigiGreen Postal Employees". The session, held via Microsoft Teams, brought together training managers and professionals from across the PostEurop Members to discuss innovative strategies for preparing employees for the sector's digital and green transition.



The webinar opened with a compelling introduction by Dr. Antonino Scribellito, Head of Projects at PostEurop. Dr. Scribellito set an inspiring tone, emphasizing the importance of digital and green innovations within the postal sector and the role PostEurop members play in developing training programs to drive these






advancements. His remarks highlighted the collaborative spirit of the DigiGreeNPost Project, laying the groundwork for the discussions that followed.

Mr. Vangelis Makris, EU Project Manager at AKMI International, presented the main strategies for the postal industry's Digital and Green Transition. His presentation focused on the development of DigiGreen courses designed to meet the evolving needs of postal employees. By detailing the course modules and the creation of a work-based learning scheme, Mr. Makris demonstrated how these programs aim to align with the industry's goals of sustainability and digital transformation.

Throughout the webinar, Mr. Angielo Andoni from PostEurop, alongside Dr. Scribellito, further elaborated on the key role of PostEurop Members in shaping the future training programs. stressed the importance of innovative training schemes in equipping postal workers with the necessary skills to meet the challenges ahead.



The webinar concluded with a shared sense of optimism for the future of the DigiGreeN Post Project, reaffirming the commitment to fostering digital and green innovation in the postal sector.
